WHO WE ARE

Tebbs Second Chances (Tebbs SC) is a registered charity in the UK and Sierra Leone, and was launched by the founder Fiona Luke in 2008 as a way to reach out and give back to her native African community.

Our mission is to help deprived communities in Africa, where educating local children can be difficult due to limited resources. Since our launch in 2008, we have successfully donated stationery items to over 3,000 children in 8 schools, and over 5,000 reading books to schools in Sierra Leone and the Gambia. In 2015, we officially launched our Sponsor a Child program, which currently sponsors 15 children across 3 schools in Sierra Leone.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

As there were no educational facilities in the area, Mr Theophilus Jumu started The Maranatha Primary School on 14th September 2006 with 65 children and 4 teachers. He wanted to ensure that the children within the community did not have to travel far by foot to have an education. Being one of two primary school in the area, the school has increased steadily each year.

Now in 2017, the school has a total of 515 students (238 boys & 277 girls) with 12 teachers. At the last National

Primary School Examinations (NPSE), the school registered 61 students, and the results were as follows: 59 passes, 1 absentee and 2 failures.

THE BUILDING PROJECT

In May 2014, Tebbs SC was awarded a generous donation from Hengist-bury Investment Partners LLP, which enabled us to replace the Maranatha Primary School's old pan building with a new cement building. Due to the Ebola crisis, however, work did not begin until April 2016.

CONDITION OF THE SCHOOL BEFORE THE BUILDING WORK

The old school building was a long makeshift tin shaft with poor ventilation, causing sauna-like conditions in the classrooms during the dry season, and water leaks during the rainy season due to damaged roofing. The building consisted of 4 classrooms with up to 65 children in each. Due a severe lack of space, 2 subjects were taught in each room at the same time.

THE BUILDING PLAN

In April 2016, with the help of our sponsor, construction began on a single-storey rectangular building with 8 classrooms, and space for a library/computer room which will enable IT access to wider teaching and learning resources.
